### **ACT Question of the Day...**

English: Grammar Basics

**Q.** Cynthia would like to go to Africa, but the airfare is unable to be afforded by her.

**A: Unnecessary passive**

We would call this sentence "wordy," but the wordiness is caused by the passive construction. Writing it this way is much better: "Cynthia would like to go to Africa but can't afford the airfare." The phrase *like to go* is idiomatically correct.
